Sankta Lucia

Sarah Dupuich is of Franco-Swedish decent, but grew up in Norrfjärden, Piteå, Sweden. Her northern origins transpire in her cooking, emphasising local and ecological produce, from the ground to the table. Her culinary experiences include a prestigious list of Michelin star eateries and White Guide features, such as Grythyttans gästgivargård, Vassa Eggen och Grands Veranda. She also ran Restaurang Doktorsvillan for 8 years, before starting her own project “Hemma hos Kallskänkan”, based out of her home. Her Lapland menu features classic flavours from the forest and mountains.



Prix d'Excellence is the annual award of the Swedish Chamber of Commerce in France, recognising innovative Swedish companies for their outstanding performances on the French market.

Sankta Lucia represents light in the dark and hymn of hope. It is one of the finest Swedish traditions. Rich in both mysteries and signs, it evokes the day that is reborn and the approaching Christmas festivities. Celebrated on December 13th, the longest night of the year according to the ancient Julian calendar, Sankta Lucia was originally a religious festivity that came from Sicily in the 18th century. The ceremony we know today dates from 1927. Sankta Lucia is crowned with candles and surrounded by young girls and boys dressed in long white dresses, singing to the arrival of the light.

Le Pavillon Vendôme, the historic landmark of Banque de Suède et de Paris was created in 1913 and later acquired by Ivar Kreuger, famous Swedish businessman at the origin of many of our large Swedish multinationals of today. Banque de Suède et de Paris remains an iconic symbol of Swedish companies and of French-Swedish businesses.
