Epiroc France Award 2025 - Prize of Excellency for European Industrial Sovereignty



Epiroc France is awarded the 2025 Prix d'Excellence for European Industrial Sovereignty by the Swedish Chamber of Commerce in France, in recognition of its strong performance and significant development on the French market. The company's recent acquisitions in France send a strong and clear signal of the group's long-term commitment to the French market, the strengthening of European competitiveness, and of the solid position of Epiroc France. With the integration of Dubuis and ACB+, France has now become Epiroc's second European base for industrial production tools and R&D — just after Sweden. This marks a true French-Swedish technological alliance.

More broadly, the Jury highlighted the strategic importance of the mining sector and critical raw materials, which lie at the heart of Europe's pursuit of independence and sovereignty. In this context, France represents a particularly promising market for Epiroc, especially with upcoming mining projects such as Émili.

The Swedish Chamber of Commerce in France's award "le Prix d'Excellence", is remitted during the "Soirée Franco-Suédoise by Her Excellency, the Ambassador of Sweden to France, on December 1st 2025 at the Pavillon Vendôme, former "Banque de Suède et de Paris".
